IDENTIFICATION TAG ON POWER



Timber is now recycled from power poles, bridges and wharves, which has had a life outside and is predominately Grey Ironbark and Spotted Gum with more imperfections.

These timbers are well seasoned but if cut the moisture content from the centre to the outer edges varies quite considerably

After the timber is cut it is dried in a kiln so the moisture equalizing process takes place before the timber is re-milled with a tongue & groove & end matched

The timbers provided by Nash Timbers to our customers are guaranteed to be from a single source. The power/transmission poles that are received by the mill have been decommissioned and deemed unserviceable by our supplier for their needs

Most poles have an identification tag denoting the characteristics of the pole including rated strength of the pole, length of the pole when in service, species and the supplier of the pole.
