



WOCA MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS – OIL REFRESHER

Maintain your oil finished floors

The [WOCA Oil Refresher's](#) main purpose is to clean and oil the floor at the same time. This is possible because of a oil/soap combination. This solution cleans and oils the floor make future clean easier. This solution should not be used more than 4 times a year and if the floor requires a more frequent cleaning, you should use the WOCA Soap and WOCA Master Soap



Tips

Do not apply the oil refresher solution until after 36 hours after the last oil application.

If too much solution is used in mixing streaks and footprints will show after the floor dries. If this happens, clean the floor with [WOCA Wood Cleaner](#).



Make sure to use a good quality mop that does not have any loose ends. We suggest the [WOCA Swep Mop](#). To mop properly, make sure to [damp mop the floor](#). The coverage is 1500-2000 square feet per liter.

Mixing

Traditional oiled floors use a solution of 1:20

UV-oiled floors use a solution of 1:40.

How to Apply

Step 1

Clean your floor well by sweeping and vacuuming to remove any loose dirt particles.

Step 2

Shake the container of WOCA Oil Refresher

Step 3

Create your solution in one bucket using lukewarm water. Also use another bucket for the rinse also using lukewarm water.

Step 4

Mop the area using the wet mop method. First using the solution, mop, then rinse but do not apply the rinsed mop to the floor. If the water solution is still visible after 3-4 minutes, the mop head is much too wet.

Step 5

Allow the floor to dry for 2 -3 hours before it is walked on.



WOCA Maintenance Oil may be used for the maintenance of all oiled wood surfaces and is especially suitable for the regular maintenance of oiled wood floors. Using the WOCA Maintenance Oil is simple by using a manual or machine application method. Product, room and floor temperature should be between 15°C–35°C. Ensure good ventilation at all times during the application and drying time.
