## **SANDING, POLISHING AND STAINING CHECK LIST – FOR BUILDER, CLIENT**

Many thanks for using Nash Timbers and Nash Finishes we appreciate the business.  
Please read and ensure that you have attended to all issues that relate to you site & job.

### **1. DUST PARTICLES ON THE BUILDING SITE**

Dust particles on the building site, furniture, joinery will be controlled to a maximum possible level by Nash Finishes Contractors (using dust free machines and tools and cover sheets on furniture), but there still will be some dust after job completion.

### **2. SKIRTINGS, DOOR JAMS AND FRAMES**

**Skirtings, door jams and frames – IS NOT RECOMMENDED TO FINISH PRIOR JOB COMPLETION.**

Masking tape to be applied to protect areas if only do a re-sand or buff

Some minor touch ups will be required specially after staining of the floor.

### **3. STAINING FLOOR**

Staining floor – Nash Finishes contractors will protect all joinery, skirting, stone marble and door jams with masking tape while applying stain on the floor, however there still will be some stain marks, depending on the difficulty, size and shape of the job. Therefore final coat by painter is recommended after the floor is finished. Nash Finishes contractors are not taking any responsibility.

### **4. ACCESS TO THE BUILDING SITE**

Access to the building site has to be clean and well maintained by the builder/client.

### **5. APPLICATION OF FINISH**

In case of using burnishing oil, splash marks can be created, which can be removed with mineral turp, but if we use acrylic finish, splash marks is not possible to remove anymore.

### **6. ELECTRIC CYCLES**

Two separate electric cycles with 15 Amp and 4 power points must be provided by the builder on the day of the job start.

### **7. ACCESS ON THE FLOOR**

There is strictly NO ACCESS on the floor, while Nash Finishes contractors are sanding and polishing floors unless discussed otherwise. Access on the floor after the job was completed has to be checked with Nash Finishes contractors and strictly followed

If any of these points on this check list are not followed by Builder/Client, it can cause damage to newly applied finish. In this case Nash Finishes contractors are not taking any responsibility for consequences and are not prepared to carry cost for repair.
